SECTION VII - SPILL OR LEAK PROCEDURES

Soak up material with absorbent material (sand, sawdust, vermiculite) and place into closed container for disposal. Note: Dispose of all wastes in accordance with Federal, State and Local regulations.

SECTION VIII - PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

VENTILATION: Adequate ventilation is essential to prevent vapor build-up. Open all available windows and entrances to insure good ventilation. RESPIRATOR PROTECTION: Adequate ventilation is normally sufficient. If eyes begin to water or dizziness or headaches are experienced, increase fresh air supply, wear an NIOSH approved respirator, or leave the area.
